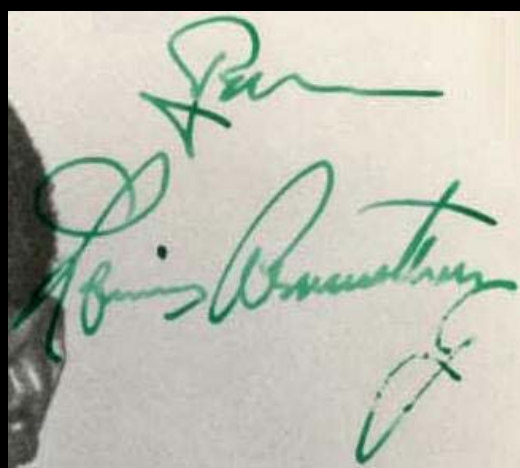

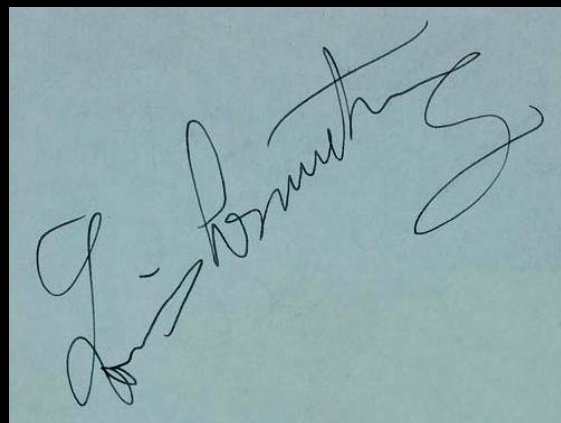

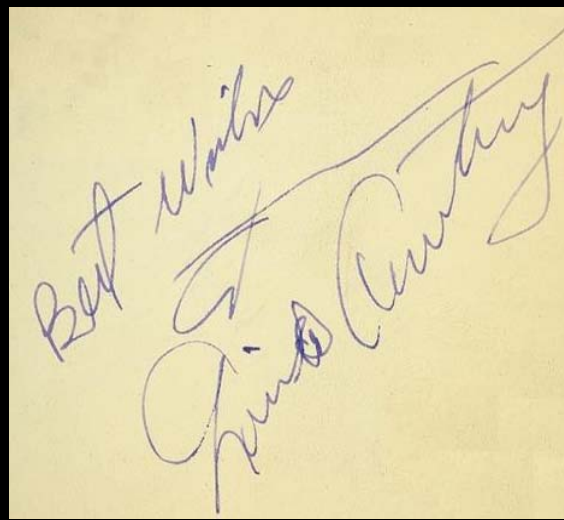
Signature in fountain pen (1952)



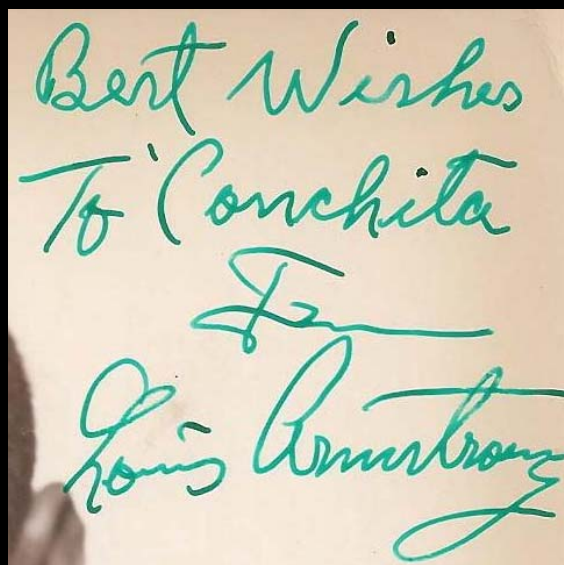

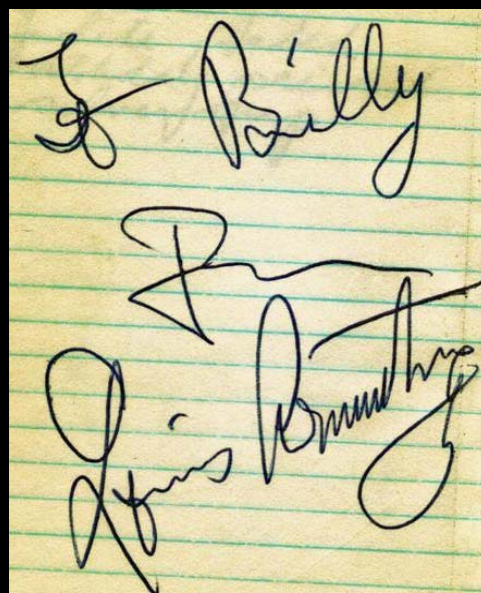
