







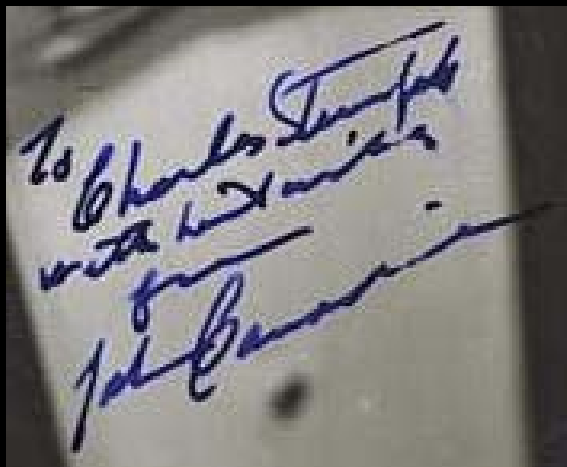

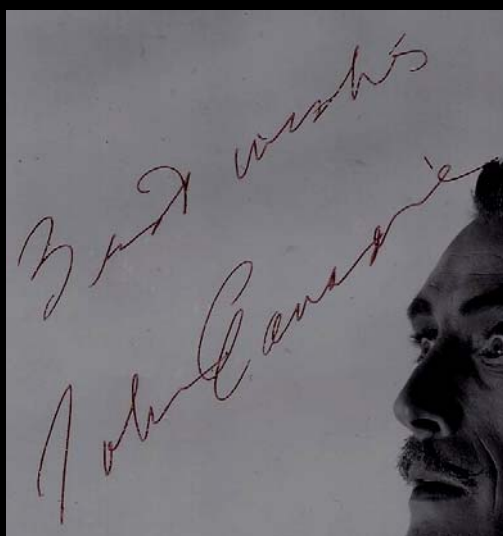

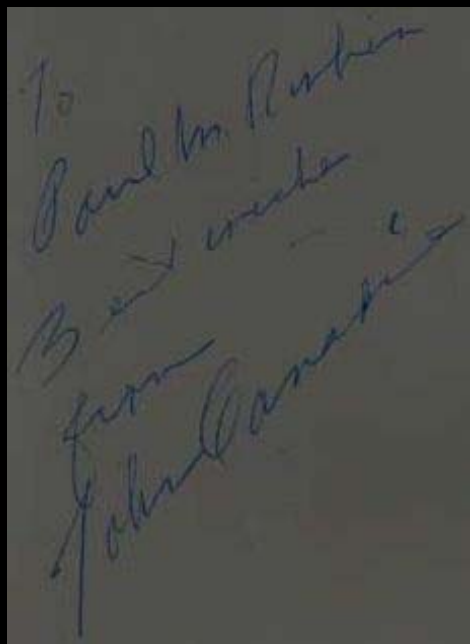

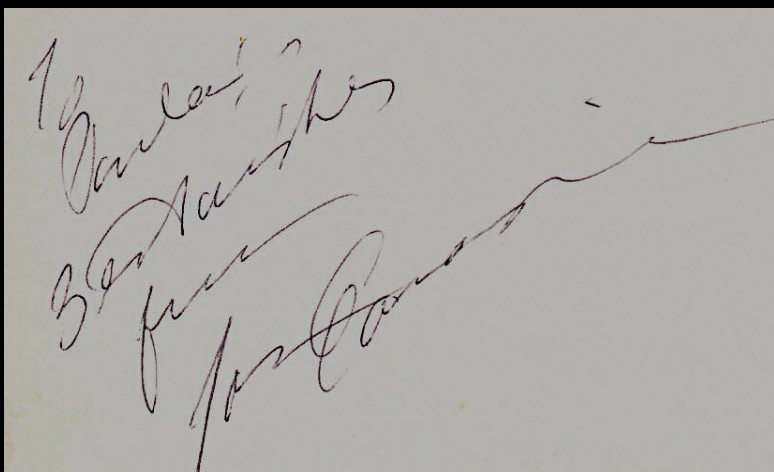

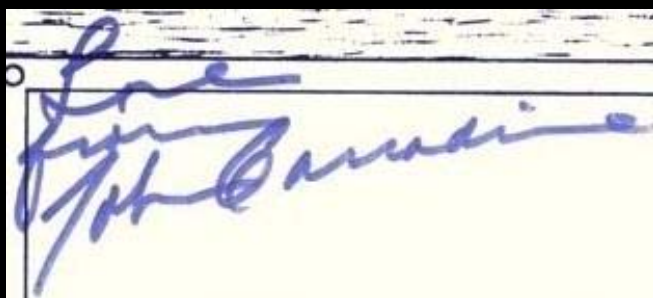
Signature in fine-tip pen (c. 1963)




