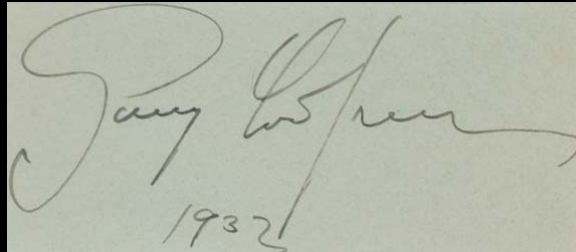

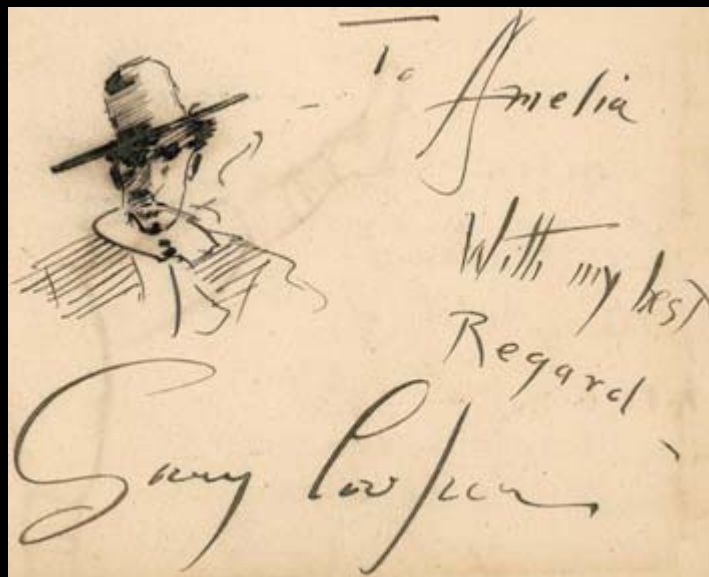

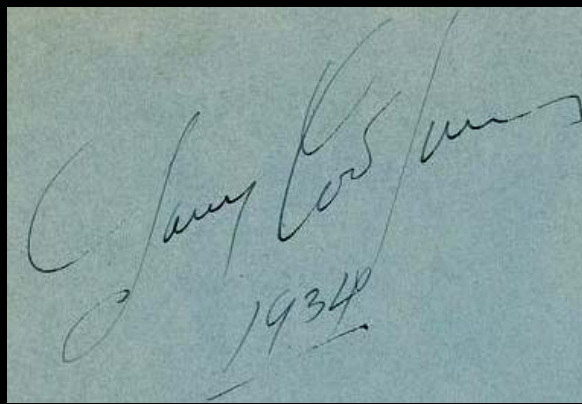
Signature in pencil (1930)



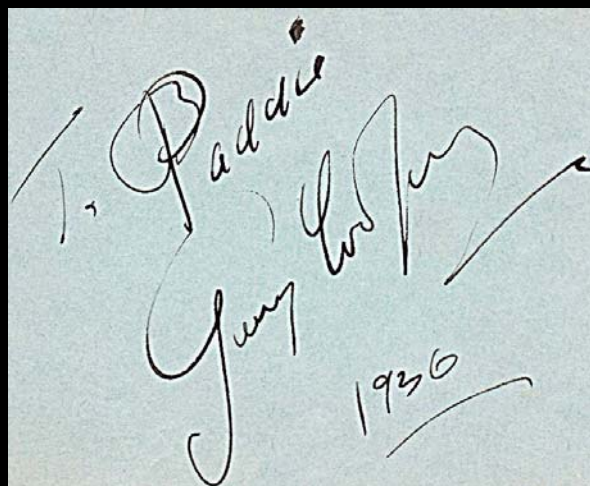

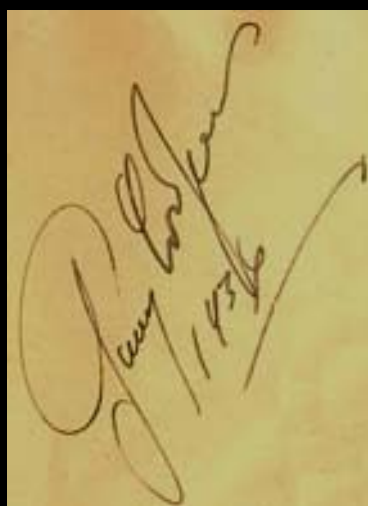
Sketch and signature in fountain pen (1933)

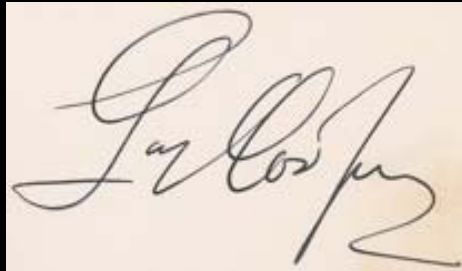
