





Signature in pencil (1932)



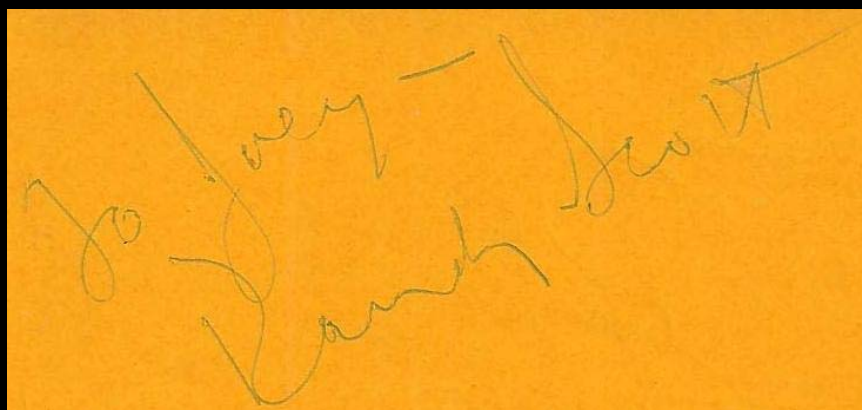

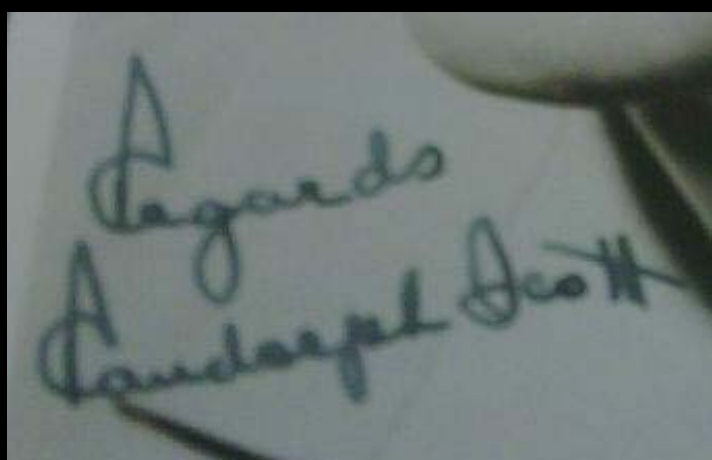
